

Scandinavian Heritage Days Quilt Show Guidelines May 26 and May 27, 2023

This is an informal non-judged show with the goal of promoting the art of quilting, and encouraging quilt-makers of all levels to share their work.

How to Enter:

A quilt-maker may submit up to two quilts. In the event that more quilts are entered than there is room for, selection of entries will be at the discretion of the show committee.

Quilts may be pieced, appliquéd, machined or hand quilted. You may enter large, small, miniature or other quilted items. Tied quilts are not encouraged.

Bring quilts to the Ephraim CO-OP on or before Wednesday, May 24.
You may also call **Tracie Bradley (435-340-0535)** to arrange a drop off time.

Quilts must be brought in with the submitter's name, address and phone number attached to the back of the quilt.

An entry form must be complete and submitted with each quilt. The bottom portion of the entry form will be displayed on the front of your quilt for the public to read. Please make it as legible as possible.

Submit quilts in disposable plastic bags. Pillowcases/individual carrying cases are discouraged.

Calendar of Events:

Wednesday, May 24: Quilts may be brought to the Ephram CO-OP building any time between 10:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Thursday, May 26: Quilts will be hung by the committee, beginning at 10:00 a.m.

Friday, May 27: Quilt Show open for viewing 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
(If you are interested in being a hostess during the show, please contact Tracie Bradley to set up a time.)

Saturday, May 28: Quilt show open for viewing 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
Pick up quilts at 5:30 p.m.

If you are not available to pick your quilt up on Saturday, you may claim it the home of Tracie Bradley in Manti.

Awards

People's Choice Awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be given.

Also a quilt will be selected by the Scandinavian Heritage Days Quilt Committee as an award winner.

If the quilt was not made by the submitter, it will be displayed but not voted on.
